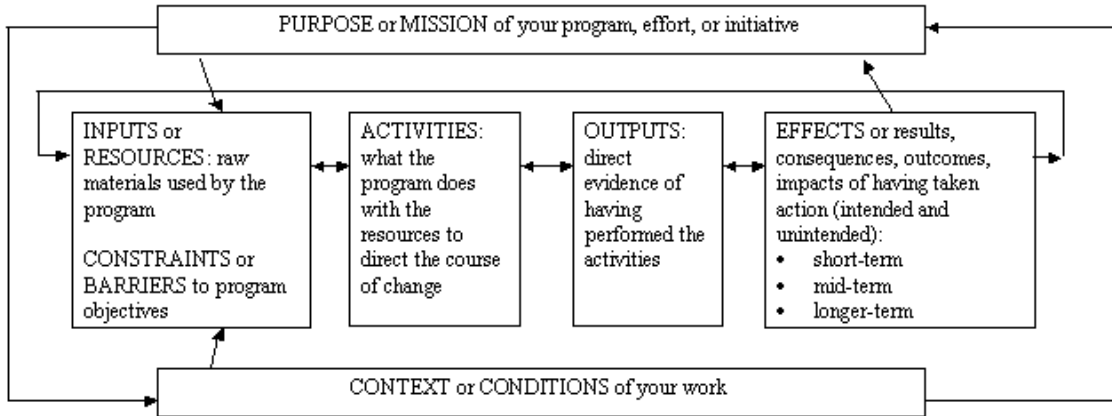

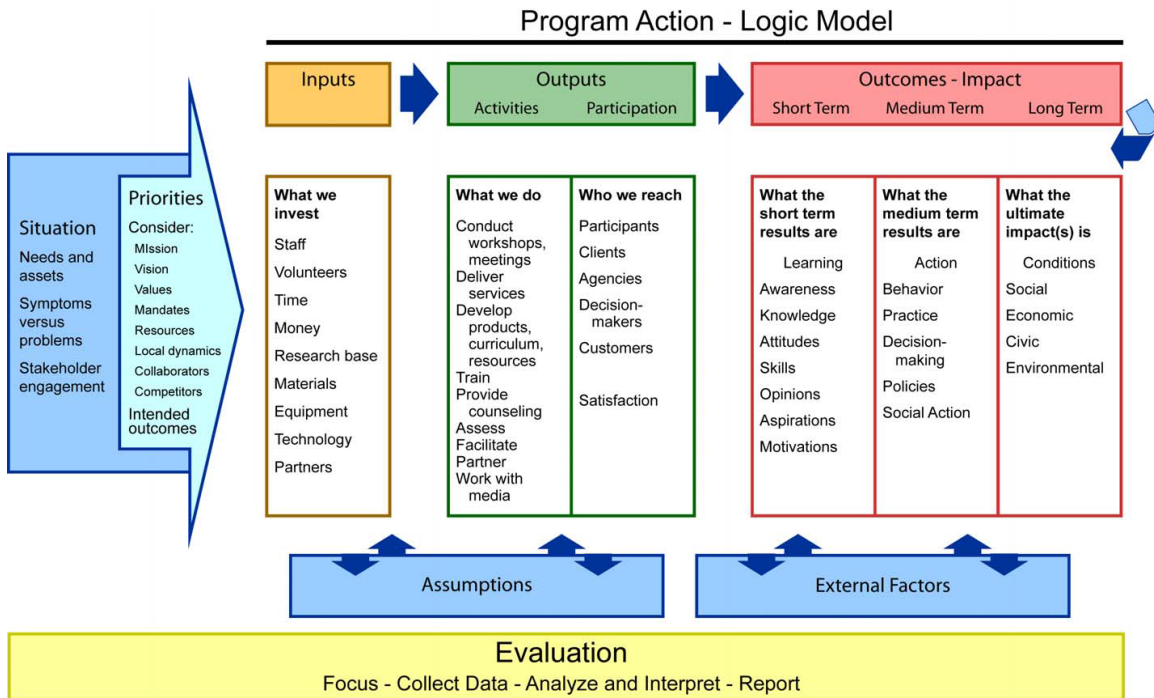

SAMPLE PLAN B<sup>2</sup>

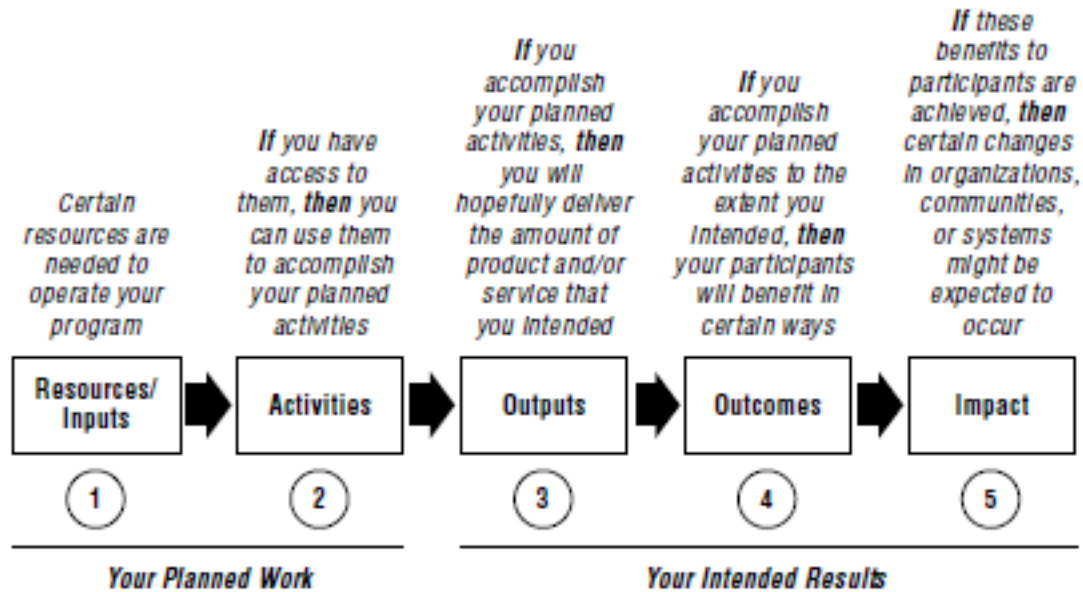
